It is in furtherance of this objective that 200 laptops are being provided free of charge to Nigeria for deployment during the first week of March, 2007 in a pilot project at the LEA Primary School Galadima located in Gwarinpa, FCT, Abuja. The pilot project (test period) is expected to last three months (1st March - 31st May, 2007), after which the laptops will be re-exported for de-bugging and
