Luann Guleserian, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1746, affirms as follows:

1. In January 2003, I was a Strategic Relationship Manager in the Sales and Marketing Group for Intel Corporation ("Intel"). In this position, I was responsible for enabling and marketing for certain operating system vendors, including The SCO Group, Inc. ("SCO"). I have worked at Intel since 1984.

2. I attended the Linux World 2003 convention in New York, New York in January 2003. At no time did anyone named Karen Smith or any other IBM representative communicate to me that IBM was terminating its business relationship with SCO or that IBM wanted Intel to stop doing business with SCO.

3. To the best of my knowledge, neither Ms. Smith nor any other IBM representative ever, directly or indirectly, informed Intel that IBM had decided to terminate its relationship with SCO or asked Intel to stop doing business with SCO.

4. To the best of my knowledge, Intel has not in any way altered its relationship with SCO because of any statements or actions by IBM or any representatives of IBM.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the foregoing is true and correct.
