Joseph Beyers, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1746, affirms as follows:


1. I am currently Vice President of Intellectual Property Licensing at Hewlett-Packard Company ("HP"). In this capacity, I am responsible for managing the Intellectual Property Licensing efforts of HP. I have worked at HP for 31 years.

2. HP has done business with The SCO Group, Inc. ("SCO"), or its predecessor, The Santa Cruz Operation, Inc., since the mid-1980s. HP continues to do business with SCO, and has a variety of business relationships with SCO, ranging from licensing SCO's intellectual property, including UNIX, to joint marketing and promotions activities.

3. To the extent HP may have reduced or altered its business relationship with SCO, HP has not in any way reduced or altered its relationship with SCO because of any statements or actions of IBM or any representatives of IBM.
