**ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS' MOTION TO PRESENT
EVIDENCE AND TESTIMONY RELATED TO THE DEBTORS'
2007 INCENTIVE PROGRAM UNDER SEAL**

Upon the motion (the "Motion") of the above-captioned debtors in possession (collectively, the "Debtors") seeking authority, pursuant to section 107(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rule 9018 and Local Rule 9018-1(b), to present evidence and testimony related to the Incentive Bonus Motion² under seal; and it appearing that the relief requested is in the best interests of the Debtors' estates, their creditors, and other parties in interest; and it appearing that this Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and it appearing that this matter is a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and it appearing that venue of these proceedings and the Motion is proper in this District pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and notice of the Motion and the opportunity for a hearing on the Motion was appropriate under the particular circumstances and no other or further notice need be given; upon the record herein, after due deliberation thereon, good and

sufficient cause exists for the granting of the relief as set forth herein, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The Debtors are authorized to present evidence and testimony containing Confidential Information under seal.
3. The Court shall seal the Courtroom and the transcripts of the hearing on the Incentive Bonus Motion as necessary to prevent disclosure of the Confidential Information, however the Office of the United States Trustee shall remain in the Courtroom, provided, however, that the Office of the United States Trustee shall not disclose the Confidential Information.
4. This Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
