**ORDER APPROVING NOVELL'S MOTION FOR ENTRY OF ORDER
CONFIRMING CONSTRUCTIVE TRUST AND
DIRECTING THE DEBTORS TO PAY FUNDS TO NOVELL**

Novell's Motion for Entry of Order Confirming Constructive Trust and Directing the Debtors to Pay Funds to Novell (the "Motion") of Novell, Inc. ("Novell"), having been duly served and noticed, came on regularly for hearing at 9:30 a.m. on November 20, 2008.

Appearances were noted in the record. Having consider the Motion, the opposition of debtors and debtors in possession The SCO Group, Inc. and SCO Operations, Inc. (together, "SCO"), such other support and opposition as may have been filed, the arguments of counsel and the record in this case, and based thereon,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Motion is granted; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that SCO holds the sum of \$625,486.90 in constructive trust for Novell, such funds not being property of SCO's bankruptcy estates; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that SCO shall pay the funds held in constructive trust for Novell, to wit, \$625,486.90, forthwith; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the enforcement or implementation of this Order.
