technical cooperation. I am not familiar with their current business, but it can't be very lucrative. At first they wanted to license us their kernel so we could put an OS/2 subsystem on top of it. I told them that this was an area where we had substantial development so it probably is not fruitful. Nevertheless they want to come out and have an exploratory discussion to see if there is any way we can cooperate. They will bring out their senior architect (from france where they are based) and give a technical presentation on what they have done, followed by business discussion (which may not amount to much). At any rate, it should be interesting.

Please reply to Alana if you are interested in attending, and/or forward this to the appropriate people in your group if you do not want to come yourself. Alana will coordinate the meeting schedule with Chorus, and we will distribute any data they can get us ahead of time.


