We never talk about the kind of environment we recommend for software development, meaning hardware and system software, I believe we should.

High resolution display cards (super-vga for example) and 16" monitors are not very expensive anymore.

Also OS/2 still offers advantages for programmers. Even if you want to develop Windows apps, compilation and debugging is much better under OS/2 and WFO allows you do develop Win apps under OS/2. This way you also make sure it works with OS/2 and it is more likely you won't have much trouble to switch to Win32 later.
