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This is pretty important. You should also do this before installing bambi — if you have a corrupted disk, adding bambi wont help.

Also, I rum a dos prompt VM and frequently do a chkdsk. DO NDT do chkdsk /f, just chkdsk on each drive you are caching. If you see lost clusters, dont worry too much — there are lots of valid cases where this is ok. (like an app has written data to the disk but hasn't closed the file yet.) If you exit from windows and you still have lost clusters, then get scott or chuck. If you see anything worse like cross linked files or other dire sounding problems, don't do anything — get scott or chuck.

By the way, I'm running bambi on my wrmail machine and did an expunge which took about 1/5 th the time it takes with smartdry.
