This is the child windows issue when Sch+ kicks off from inside Mail. When you do a custom message class, you can't minimize within mail like, for example, the inbox or outbox. It is the only hook that I have not gotten code for and we have not provided to the ISV world. It is a purely visual thing and there is a way to functionally do the exact thing. Russ, if you would like, we can meet/chat and I can walk you through all the work/block diagrams that I have with regard to this and the WfW hooks. Tim Dempsey from Lotus called about two/three weeks ago asking about this, so I would guess that Cam's hunch is right on.
