I am really unclear how IBM can afford to have the normal sales force talk about Os/2 and support Os/2. Perhaps they really still believe it helps then self their profitable products. I think it is a left over of the old grand SAA strategy. When does Wheeler really leave the company?

This whole issue of the broad IBM sales force selling against us is one I want to figure out how to raise with Gerstner when I see him on May 25. Any new datapoints on this will be helpful.

I think the public perception or at least the press perception has changed away from believing Os/2 will defeat Windows. Rather there is a view that it is a nice operating system that will continue to have some role.
