mac system 7 lets run multiple apps and have their windows on screen. they have a task switcher icon at the right of the system menu bar. how do they deal with the concept of "minimized app"? simply by allowing you to "hide" a running app, from the task switcher menu. this takes the app off the desktop but leaves it in the task list. or you can have "hide all" to hide all apps but the active on. easy, simple, clean. compare their task switcher to ours.
