The position BillG has taken is that Norton and CPS have needed license from us on the Win UI, though I don't know for sure whether we actually executed such a license—Certainly we will defend the copyright against Novell, and I know BillG has said that we will enforce against anyone who attempts to clone Windows.

I don't think giving them the logo for PNW will do anything to make them more supportive of Chicago. They will be fundamentally opposed to Chicago because it is extremely threatening to them strategically. It does not rely on ms-dos so they lose their chance to install client code underneath windows; it pushes the windows platform ahead (api-wise, technology-wise, etc) killing their efforts to clone windows, and it includes netware client code, which destroys their leverage in trying to hold chicago hostage, as they did with wfw and nt. what the windows cloners want to do is freeze the world at win 3.1 so it's a static target that they can clone and also build their middleware on top of. With the world frozen at win 3.1, they can position themselves as the supplier of connectivity; you can see this already with pnw by trying to layer themselves on top of windows and isolating the user from windows (even to the extent of having their own gdi api!)

I expect to see Novell pull every stunt they can to kill chicago
