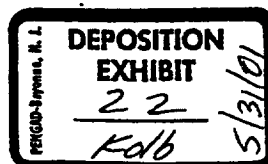

OK my comments.

- 1) You have certain languages in the product table (ZH, XT, XC) that are not defined below the table. I don't know what these languages are and neither will the account managers. Is this a mistake or should we update the language key below the table by adding these three languages? [Ed McCahill] Take another look in Row 29. They are all listed there. I think your confusion may be that the key is sorted alphabetically by language (eg "Chinese-Simplified") rather than by code ("XT"). I changed the sort criteria in the revised version below.
- 2) Your memo says we will restrict Excel licensing on a standalone basis. This is fine except have we considered the possibility of existing licenses for Excel 97 that will now have a reduced language list for the Excel 2000 product. No problem with the logic just want to prethink how to handle the complaints if there will be any from current Excel 97 licensees. [Ed McCahill] I'm not aware that we have any existing Excel license deals with any of the languages I deleted. I looked into this a few months ago and found none, which is why I killed them. It's possible that changed without my knowledge since then. We've also always had Excel as a restricted product because of the desire to move OEMs up to Office.
- 3) Memo says we will lower 97 prices sometime in the future. I'll assume that will be a separate event and we will communicate that to AM later rather than now. If you tell them now they will want the lower price on the newer product release. [Ed McCahill] Correct that it will be a separate event in the future for Word 97 (the only 97 app we'll continue to offer post-2000 launch). Good point about not communicating it right now. I only put that in the memo (not as a comment on the PGL) because that was just FYI for JK & Staff.
- 4) We should take the (XT ships @ SR1) notation out of this since it could set expectations that might be missed. Licenses are typically written such that the noted language is licensed if and when available. Either take XT out for now or take out the notation and it will be available when it's available. [Ed McCahill] Another good point. I've removed all XT listings. We will add them in late this year when they are expected to be available (SR1).

Otherwise, are we set to roll?
