The ||intent of the call would be to ask that MS treat them like any other ||OEM when it comes to Win'95 since they are licensing MS-DOS/Windows on ||their systems.

|| By the way, I understand from an outside source that OS/2 WARP does not || Irun on the Apple Intel compatible systems (this is unconfirmed by MS || Idirectly). They have not used OS/2 WARP as a threat in the past but I || Iexpect it will become one if we are not willing to work with them on || Win'95.

We need to decide how to proceed with Apple. We are working on setting up a meeting between Ian Diery and Steveb (an old meeting that Steveb requested) which has not been arranged yet due to scheduling lissues. I suspect this will also come up as an issue in that meeting.
