Below are the 23 action items that were generated at the April 16 meeting.

- 1. Make the following changes to the Windows Vital Signs spreadsheet: (Tomja to route 4/22)
- a) Fit info onto 2 pages
- b) Add DOS/Win bundle sales data.
- c) Add Mouse/Win units to the Direct Account Sell-Through section.
- d) Add to PSS section: # Full Time Equivalent Windows Technicians
 Explain the Satisfaction measure
- e) Change Reg. Base section to reflect additional users/month.
- f) Remove Update units from the Word and Excel sales numbers.
- g) Add WinApp penetration = (Word + Excel)/Windows units
- h) Add SPA Windows applications data.
- i) Send the completed spreadsheet to all Executives, BUMs, Focus Squad and direct reports to Bradsi.

- 4 a) Report specifics of UAE problems that PSS is handling. What are they, when, where, why do they occur.
- b) Present list to David Cole and get schedule for their resolutions. (Winmktg and PSS to resolve by 5/1)
- 5. Work with PSS to track call time by issue. Report the % of call time spent on each of the top 10 issues. (Winmktg and PSS 5/1)
- 6. Add the fixed HP LaserJet driver onto the SDL. (Tomja to investigate)
- 7. Get the top 5 Windows issues from WinExcel's and WinWord's PSS queues.

 Add these to the list of PSS issues. (Winmktg and PSS 5/1)
- Work with Lotus and WordPerfect to train their PSS technicians. (PSS and WinMktg to meet to resolve)
- 9. Get a complete list of PSS call codes with explanations. (PSS and Winmktg to route to Pocus Squad by 4/23)
- 10. Generate a plan to publicize Windows User Satisfaction. (PR and Winmktg to meet on 4/23 to develop plan)
- 11. Set up a database for MSD print-outs. (Tomja to investigate)
- 12. Plan an incentive for people on Compuserve to submit MSD info. (Tomja to investigate, plan by 5/1)
- 13. Do not give Windows reg. base to Lotus. (JonL has proposal. See email from him.)
- 14. Develop a long term Reg. Base policy.

- 15. Send mail to field: There is no Chinese wall. (RussW by 5/1)
- 16. Prepare a plan to create a DOS5/Windows Setup. (Tomja to investigate. Recommendations by 5/1)

- 17. Prepare a plan for getting the Press to go to Windows Tech. Workshops. (PR and Winmktg to coordinate on 4/23)
- 18. Get copies of the Focus On Windows newsletter to Windows Focus Squad. (Winmktg to route by 4/23)
- 19. Put a Satisfaction Questionnaire in the next newsletter. (Jonro to add to FY'92 Plan)
- 20. Incorporate the Windows Technical Workshop into Windows World and the Windows Discovery Fairs. (Jonro to implement)
- 21. Get Windows columns in PC Week and PC Magazine. (Winmktg to coordinate with PR on 4/23)
- 22. Prepare a recommendation as to whether the next version of Windows should be 3.1 or 3.5. (Winmktg to prepare by 5/1)
- 23. Write a PR Plan. (PR to Prepare)
