## John,

A variety of things have come up during the past several days that I need to touch base with you about.

- See memo attached to Richard Deans inquiring about Autocad 10 326 and Movell 386 Natural versions in use; FYI, no response required.
- See mamo attached providing a report on MS DOS 5.0: FMI, no response required.
- A customer is using a program called BOOTCOM.SYS which fails under DR DOS 5.0 (this will be SPR'd as soon as I have the program in hand and can test it myself). BOOTCOM runs in COMPIC.SYS and permits the user to set an environment variable corresponding to a specific set of COMPIG.SYS commands to be executed. This variable can then be picked up by AUTOEXEC.BAT to permit execution of only a subset of AUTOEXEC.BAT statements.

EXAMPLE:

if net "%BOOTCOR\*"--"A" gots not\_a lines that pertain to config.sys "a" option inot\_a
lines that pertain to config.sys \*b\* option

Is there any undocumented functionality within DR DOS 5.0 which will permit an environment variable to be set based on the CONFIG.SYS lines chosen, and passed to the AUTOEXEC.BAT?

- 4. A number of programmers have been asking for access to PASSWORD verification from within their programs. Is there a system call which can be made to have the operating system verify a password?
- On a related note, a little-known network called WEB works fine with DR DOS 5.0, except when any files have a password attached.

- 7. Microsoft will be releasing Windows 3.1 in the near future. This version will allegedly run under third party memory managers which are written to Microsoft specifications. Do you corrently have any plans to acquire this specification and modify MMD36.675 to directly support Windows 3.x?
