The suggested retail price of the 1-2-3 Release 3.1 Standard Edition is \$595. The network Server and Node Editions of the product will be available in the fourth quarter of 1990 at a suggested retail price of \$795 and \$495, respectively.

All customers who purchased 1-2-3 Release 3.0 before May 7, 1990, may upgrade to Release 3.1 for \$35. Users who buy or have bought 1-2-3 Release 3.0 on or after May 7, 1990, are entitled to a free upgrade to Release 3.1 through December 31, 1990. 1-2-3 Release 2.2 users may upgrade for a suggested retail price of \$75 through December 31, 1990. Users of 1-2-3 Release 1, 1A, 2, and 2.01 may upgrade to 1-2-3 Release 3.1 for a suggested retail price of \$150.
