Well! we all agree that Slick should be based on DOS 5.0a but we are still trying to find out what DOS 5.0a is?

Given the fact that PSS has 96% busy rate (i.e. only 4% people get through), we can safely assume that the bugs that we have received so far from PSS are only a tip of the iceburg.

I suggest that we do the following:

 Review all bugs that are coming through PSS to decide whether these bugs would be fixed in DOS 5.0a, we would suggest a workaround or document the problem. We could use frequency of calls to PSS as a guideline but it may be misleading because of difficulty in getting to PSS.

We would also monitor COmpuserve forum and apply the same criterion to the bugs reported on the forum by the users.

- 2. We should wait until middle of August to see what other problems are discovered before we close DOS 5.0a or else we are setting ourselves for DOS 5.0b and so on (probably DOS of the month club). We would continue to fix bugs that pass the DOS 5.0a selection criterion but won't be code complete until middle of august.
- 3. We should use Slick as beta vehicle to test DOS 5.0a but this brings other interesting questions. Given a 4-6 week of beta cycle and 2 weeks of final system test, we are looking at slick being released at the end of september to middle of october (based on the fact that we won't have code complete until middle of sugust).

Do we still continue with Slick being based on DOS 5.0a and windows 3.0? or Should slick be based on DOS 5.0a and Windows 3.1, given the fact that Windows 3.1 is going to be announced soon after the Slick release.
