# Varitest

90-95% completion by 2nd August.

Testing progressing with no major problems found.

Problems found:

DISKOPT and disk corruption - cannot reproduce

DELWATCH and PRINTQ - isolated and fixed

TaskMAX and Microsoft mice and EGA support which will be addressed by Joe Wein during this week as a priority.

Compatibility with Mathematica which they will supply to us for testing.

#### Microsoft.

Microsoft Windows 3.1 will not be supported in anhanced mode because a modified LOADHI VXD driver is required from Microsoft. No further information.

Microsoft windows 3.0 and 3.0A extended the kernel of windows to 64kb under DR DOS thus imposing a maximum TPA of 576kb for DOS applications running in enhanced mode. This cannot be fixed in Buxton.

## ADDSTOR

Getting a number of compatibility issues from UK, German and US offices. Problems appear to be with hardware. Will be visiting the Newbury office to try on machines that have not been used for beta testing. 13 machines have been made available for testing.

Bill Castle will be in Monterey 30/7/91 to investigate problems from this office and give Tech Support training.

Received SSTOR and driver conversion program which can be translated. Testing and QA to be done at EDC.

# Areas of concern:

- Completion of TaskMAX 31 outstanding SPR's.
- Volume of SPR's arriving at this late stage in the project.

- Complete support for ADDSTOR drives in the DISKOPT utility.

# Functional changes from Spec

- No screen blanking is provided in the product.
- Support for AMD286 and ZX chip set will be integrated as soon as stable chip development kits become available.
