The last info I had said that they run Windows 3 via a DOS emulator, likely Merge 386 from Locus. There was no decision as to whether MS-DOS or DR DOS would be provided with the emulator, Novell would favor the latter for obvious reasons but Univel's customers might prefer the real McCoy. I'm hoping that Grover Righter can confirm. It'll be an interesting licensing issue if Univel ships DR DOS because Locus has a license with us that says they pay for MS DOS everytime they ship Merge 386.

I have heard rumor of an actual Windows 3 emulator. I can't imagine one but there has been talk on the subject. To my knowledge, XDOS still lacks the ability to handle complex graphics and that was one of the better DOS-to-UNIX products.
