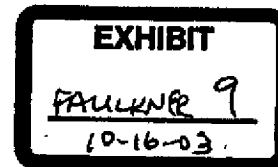

Hi Aurum,

We have a version of our Burstware plug-in for Windows Media Player-7 that we would like you to test.

Please recall that the current Burstware plug-in, for WMP-6, allows MPEG-1 (and AVI) files to be delivered to WMP-7, but there was a limitation around ASF.

If you are targeting ASF, we can send you the initial release (we are calling it an alpha release). It works perfectly with current Burstserver software, to deliver ASF (and WMA) to WMP-7.
