Per our discussions, we understand that MusicNet desires to use the Windows Media Format Software Development Kit 9 Series with a DRM client contribute to develop an application that queries the DRM playcount in the Windows Media license store on an end user's machine ("MusicNet Application") in order to desermine whether such an application would be useful in tracking and uses play counts and pay royalties to content providers. While the MusicNet Application, as we understand it, may not qualify as a "Licensed Application" under the DRM Addendum to End User License: Agreement for the Microsoft Windows Media Formal Saftware Development Kit 9 Series ("License Agreement"), Microsoft nevertheless hereby authorises MusicNet under the License Agreement to develop the MusicNet Application for its own internal evaluation purposes for a period of three (3) months. Musiches may not, however, distribute the Musiches Application to third parties, and all other terms and conditions of the License Agreement remain applicable.
