DR-DOS is not recognizing Home and End on the keypad (yes, I have Num Lock turned off) It DOES recognize Home and End on the set of keys above the arrow keys.

This bug is important because in DOSBook, CTRL+HOME and CTRL+END are used to go to the top and bottom of a topic. If you are running DOSBOOK from the Shell and you have Task Switcher turned on, CTRL+END takes you to Task Switcher instead of to the bottom of the DOSBook topic. In a Hypertext system, losing your context unexpectedly like that is bad news.
