5) Repositioning alternatives for OS/2 and Lan: given OS/2 is not the "successor to DOS" (Win 3 is) then how can we best position OS/2 on the desktop and Lan/OS/2 on the server Impact on key OEM accounts and overall revenue should be considered.

Owner: same as #4
