Given the Ofoto acquisition, Kodak has chosen to *not* include Ofoto in the builds anymore. It is no longer listed on current builds (time to upgrade).

We don't require more than passport implementation on the server side as part of OOB from my understanding (note that the OS and services are still evolving such that different services and/or implementations within the service will appear in the next few months). JonSc and MMaggs are negotiating requirements for OOB partners now. You can contact them if you want to provide input.
