Gentlemen:

Re: April 1, 1979 Software Agreement, as Modified, between AT&T Technologies, Inc. (formerly Western Electric Company, Incorporated) and The Regents of the University of California Relating to UNIXtm 32V Time-Sharing System, Version 1.0 ("32V") and Proposed License Agreement Between The Regents of the University of California and American Telephone and Telegraph Company Relating to Fourth Berkeley Software Distribution

This supplements my letter to you of September 15, 1983, which permitted you to distribute your versions of source code for 32V to parties who are licensees of American Telephone and Telegraph Company ("AT&T") for the initial version of UNIX System V, and supersedes our Mr. D. W. Frasure's July 30, 1984 letter to your Ms. Pauline Schwartz. 32V is licensed to you pursuant to the referenced Software Agreement.

We propose that, subject to execution by both parties of the Proposed License Agreement, you be permitted to distribute your versions of source code for 32V (known as Fourth Berkeley Software Distribution, releases 4.1 BSD, 4.2 BSD and 4.3 BSD) to parties who are licensees of AT&T or an affiliated company thereof for any version of UNIX System V, provided that you:

- (i) confirm the status of each requesting licensee by telephoning AT&T Information Systems' Software Sales and Licensing Organization on 800-828-UNIX;
- (ii) maintain a record of each such confirmation and distribution, such record to include, by licensee, the date of such confirmation, the name of the person at AT&T Information Systems providing such confirmation, and the date of distribution of your version of source code; and
- (iii) forward to AT&T Information Systems' Software Sales and Licensing Organization at the above address a copy of such record for the preceding three months within thirty (30) days after each March 31, June 30, September 30 and December 31.

We understand that your distribution of releases 4.1 BSD, 4.2 BSD and 4.3 BSD is fee-free except for a nominal service charge to cover the cost of distribution.

If you agree with the above proposal, please so indicate by signing and dating the attached copy of this letter agreement in the spaces provided therefor below and returning such copy to us.
