**NOTICE OF TWENTY-THIRD MONTHLY
APPLICATION OF TANNER LC FOR COMPENSATION
FOR SERVICES AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES, AS
ACCOUNTANTS TO THE DEBTORS FOR THE PERIOD
FROM JULY 1, 2010 THROUGH JULY 31, 2010**

TO: Parties required to receive notice pursuant to Del. Bankr. L.R. 2002-1.

On September 14, 2010, the Twenty-Third Monthly Fee Application of Tanner LC (“*Tanner*”) as Accountants to the Debtors, for Compensation for Services and Reimbursement of Expenses for the Period of July 1, 2010 through July 31, 2010 (“*Fee Application*”) was filed with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, 824 N. Market Street, Wilmington, Delaware 19801 (the “*Bankruptcy Court*”). By the Fee Application, Tanner seeks the allowance and payment of interim compensation in the amount of \$4,800.00 (80% of \$6,000.00) and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$226.00 incurred in representation as accountants to the Debtors during the period of July 1, 2010 through July 31, 2010 (the “*Application Period*”).

Any responses or objections to the Fee Application must be filed with the Bankruptcy Court in accordance with the local rules and served upon the undersigned counsel on or before

October 4, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. (EST). Copies of the Fee Application are available upon written request to the undersigned.

A hearing on the Fee Application shall be held only in the event timely objections are filed.

Pursuant to the Administrative Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation of Professionals, in the absence of any objection or responsive pleading to the Fee Application, Tanner is authorized to file a Certificate of No Objection with the Bankruptcy Court, after which the Debtor is authorized to pay Tanner an amount equal to 80% of the fees (\$4,800.00) and 100% of the expenses (\$226.00) requested in the Fee Application. If an objection to the Fee Application is timely filed and served, the Debtor shall be authorized to pay Tanner 80% of the fees and 100% of the expenses not subject to the objection.
