#### **DETAILED ACTION**

#### Terminal Disclaimer

The terminal disclaimer filed on January 9, 2008 disclaiming the terminal portion of any patent granted on this application which would extend beyond the expiration date of patent number 7,212,783 has been reviewed and is accepted. The terminal disclaimer has been recorded.

#### **EXAMINER'S AMENDMENT**

An examiner's amendment to the record appears below. Should the changes and/or additions be unacceptable to applicant, an amendment may be filed as provided by 37 CFR 1.312. To ensure consideration of such an amendment, it MUST be submitted no later than the payment of the issue fee.

Re claim 33, line 2: Substituted the term "Bluetooth" with --short-range wireless--.

frequency --.

Allowable Subject Matter

Claims 1-41 are allowed.

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

Re claims 1 and 25: The prior art of record, taken alone or in combination, fail to teach or fairly suggest, in conjunction with other limitations in the claims, a method and system for managing content between a first device and second device including the step of receiving an input to pause a content.

Re claim 41: The prior art of record, taken alone or in combination, fail to teach or fairly suggest, in conjunction with other limitations in the claims, a communication system for managing content between a first device and a second device comprising a database for storing information regarding the first device and a second device; and a controller for identifying the second device from the database and sending a second data message to the second device is response to receiving the first data message from the first device.

Any comments considered necessary by applicant must be submitted no later than the payment of the issue fee and, to avoid processing delays, should preferably accompany the issue fee. Such submissions should be clearly labeled "Comments on Statement of Reasons for Allowance."

#### Conclusion
