**ORDER NO. 21: GRANTING NON-PARTY SALESFORCE.COM., INC.'S FOURTH
UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
RESPOND TO AND/OR MOVE TO QUASH RESPONDENTS'
SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM* AND *AD TESTIFICANDUM***

(November 17, 2011)


On November 15, 2011, nonparty Salesforce.com, Inc. ("Salesforce") filed a fourth unopposed motion for an extension of time to respond to and/or move to quash subpoenas *duces tecum* and *ad testificandum*. (Motion Docket No. 769-033.) Salesforce seeks a fourth extension to respond to and/or file a motion to quash to the later of December 2, 2011 or within 5 days of respondent Barnes and Noble, Inc.'s request to produce a privilege log or produce a witness. The motion states that parties have reached an agreement on Salesforce's response to the subpoenas, but without waiver of the parties' respective rights. The motion further states that the Commission Investigative Staff and respondent Barnes and Nobles, Inc. do not oppose the motion.

Good cause being shown and there being no opposition, Motion No. 769-033 is hereby GRANTED. Salesforce shall have either until December 2, 2011 or within 5 days of respondent Barnes and Noble, Inc.'s request to produce a privilege log or provide a witness, whichever is later, to respond to and/or file a motion to quash the subpoenas.

The parties are hereby directed to coordinate forwarding a copy of this order to Salesforce.


