Dear Judge Essex:

I write concerning Complainant Microsoft Corp.'s Motion for a Protective Order Excusing Mr. Steven A. Ballmer from Testifying at the Hearing (Motion No. 769-065). On Friday afternoon, Microsoft and the Barnes & Noble respondents reached an agreement that resolves the subject of this motion. Accordingly, Microsoft withdraws this motion and the request for shortened response time.

Microsoft and Barnes & Noble have agreed to submit excerpts of Mr. Ballmer's deposition in lieu of his live testimony. This compromise permits Barnes & Noble to submit the evidence it sought from Mr. Ballmer while minimizing the burden on Mr. Ballmer and Microsoft. It also eases the burdens on the parties and Your Honor by resolving the subject of Microsoft's motion without requiring further briefing or an order from the ALJ. Finally, the parties' compromise will allow the trial to proceed more efficiently, as it eliminates one of the live witnesses Barnes & Noble sought to call.

Microsoft and Barnes & Noble have agreed to the following schedule:

 Jan. 24: Barnes & Noble will serve its designations of Mr. Ballmer's deposition transcript;

- Jan. 26: Microsoft will serve its counter-designations and its objections, if any, to Barnes & Noble's designations;
- Jan. 27: Barnes & Noble will serve its objections, if any, to Microsoft's counterdesignations;
- Jan. 30: Microsoft and Barnes & Noble will submit a joint motion for leave to admit these designations and counter-designations out of time and for the ALJ to accept the parties' objections, if any, to these designations out of time.

The parties will proceed with this schedule unless Your Honor directs otherwise. Commission Investigative Staff does not oppose this compromise solution. Please contact me if you have any questions.
